CERTIFICATION EXAMINATIONS FOR VARIOUS CADRES IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH PROFESSION

OUTLINE FOR THE EXAMINATIONS:

1. **Cadres for Certification Examination:**

The following cadres are to be covered by the Certification Examinations.

i. **Environmental Health Officers/Technologist**

- a. Candidates are to seat for 5 papers viz: - 2 written theory papers, - Environmental Health Practice 1, Environmental Health Practice 11, Multi Choice Questions (MCQ) 50 questions, Practical (Alternative to Practical) and Oral Examination.

Environmental Health Practice I

Waste Management, Building and Housing Sanitation, Water Supply and Sanitation, Food Hygiene, Pest Management and Control, Environmental Surveillance and Monitoring.

Environmental Health Practice II

Professional Ethics and Practice, Environmental Health Laws, Disease Control, Port Health Services, Occupational Health and Safety, Disease Control and Bio Statistics, Health Care Services, Health Education and Promotion.

Multi Choice Questions

This will be made up of 50 questions for one hour. The marking will entail negative marking.

Practical (Alternative to Practicals)

Different pictures on any area of Environmental Health will be accompanied by 5 questions for the candidates.

Oral

This will cover any chosen area of Environmental Health

Scoring:

Theory I	=	100%
Theory II	=	100%
MCQ	=	50%
VIVA	=	50%
Oral	=	20%

This will then be compressed into a 100% to find the candidate's score.

Pass Mark:

The pass mark for this examination is 50%, obtained in 100% score.

Failure in any of the components of this examination means total failure of the entire examination. A candidate will be allowed to attempt this examination for three times only. After the third attempt, he is advised to be retrained.

ii. **Environmental Health Technicians:**

- a. Candidates are to seat for 3 papers Viz – Oral Examination, Practical Examinations and Theory Examinations made up of Essay and Multi Choice Questions of 50.
- b. Candidates will be examined in the following subject areas – Environmental Health Ethics, Vital Statistics, Epidemiology, Building Sanitation, Health Education, Waste Management, Food Hygiene, Water Supply and Sanitation, Public Health and Nutrition, Entomology and Parasitology, Community Diagnoses and Occupational Health and Safety.

ii. **Environmental Health Assistant:**

- a. Candidates are to seat for 2 papers Viz – Theory Examinations made up of Essay and Multi Choice Questions of 50.
- b. Candidates will be examined in the following subject areas – Building Sanitation, Health Education, Occupational Health and Safety, Entomology, Primary Health Care and Disease Control, Waste Management.
