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## **2019 CERTIFICATION EXAMINATION FOR CANDIDATES WISHING TO BE REGISTERED AS ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH OFFICERS, ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH TECHNICIANS AND ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ASSISTANTS**

In pursuant of its mandate as enshrined in the enabling act, the Council has been conducting annual certification examination for entrants into the profession of Environmental Health in Nigeria. The 2019 examination is scheduled to hold between 11<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of November, 2019 at designated centres across the Country.

2. The cost of registration for the examination payable into the Federal Government TSA at any Commercial Bank is as follows:

3. You are expected to compile the names of interested candidates, accept evidence of payment of examination fees accompanied by duly completed Application Forms and forward same to the Council **before the close of work on the 30<sup>th</sup> of August 2019**. Late Registration attracts a surcharge of Five Thousand Naira (N 5, 000.00) on each candidate, and closes by the close of work on 7<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

4. Henceforth, valid certificate for EHOs includes (i) degree result or HND result from NBTE accredited schools, accompanied with NYSC document (mobilization, discharge, exemption/exclusion).

(ii) WAHEB certificate or result list may still be considered for schools yet to be accredited.

5. For Environmental Health Technicians and Assistants, Council had earlier adopted the accreditation of NBTE for HND to cover the programmes in those schools and had gone ahead to accredit the programmes in other schools yet to obtain NBTE HND Accreditation. For Schools in this category, Council will accept the school result for EHT and EHA for Council exam.


(ii) WAHEB certificate or result list may still be considered for the schools yet to be accredited by the Council in those programmes. All Forms that do not meet this condition shall be rejected and no money will be refunded. Furthermore, the minimum number of Candidates to make up an Examination Centre remains Fifty (50).

6. *Note that candidates whose names are not in the index list of the Council will pay a penalty charge of One Hundred (100%) per cent of indexing fee before such candidate will be allowed to participate in this Council Certification examination.*

7. In view of the failure rate in previous examinations, it is recommended that all candidates are exposed to a minimum of eight weeks intensive revision programmes organised by Colleges/Schools of Health Technology and accredited Environmental Health Learning Centres to enable them refresh their knowledge preparatory to sitting for the examinations.

8. You are enjoined to bring this information to the notice of concerned EHOs, EHTs and EHAs interested in taking the Examination in your Institution. It is acceptable to the Council if registration for this examination is organised by your School in collaboration with the Environmental Health Officers Association (EHOAN) in your State.

9. The examination time table and outline are enclosed for your guidance. Accept the Council's esteemed regards, please.
